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Adolescent Brain and Health Study

Volunteers Needed for Research Study

The UNL Department of Psychology is conducting research to better understand adolescent health and development.

- Adolescents ages 14 to 16 and living in Lancaster County and a parent or guardian will participate.
- Adolescents and a parent or guardian will be asked to participate in 3 data collections over about 2 years.
- The first lab session will take about 3 to 3.5 hours. The lab sessions in the second and third years will take about 1 hour each.
- Data collection includes MRI scanning, questionnaires, and physical measurements.
- Participation will take place at the Center for Brain, Biology and Behavior (CB3) in Memorial Stadium on the UNL campus. Additional data collection will occur outside the lab.
- Risks of participation are minimal.
- Total cash compensation of up to \$575 across the entire study (which includes 3 data collections over about 2 years) is available.
