Eligibility Criteria

- Adolescent is 14 to 16 years old
- Adolescent lives in Lancaster County
- A parent or legal guardian is available to participate
- Willing to attend 3 study visits over approximately 2 years

Benefits & Risks

- Total cash compensation of up to \$575 across the entire study (which includes 3 data collections over about 2 years) is available.
- Risks of participation are minimal.



Participation will take place at the Center for Brain, Biology and Behavior (CB3) in Memorial Stadium on the UNL campus. Additional data collection will occur outside the lab.
